PARTICIPATION CRITERIA:

Each Association may nominate in ranking order two players (2 girls and 2 boys, born 2004 / 2005) and one accompanying coach. National Associations should nominate their MOST TALENTED PLAYERS from whom future top performance may be expected.

Depending on the number of associations entering players ETTU could fill empty places.

If the number of entries exceeds the number of available places for the camp, players will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis considering the 2 highest ranked players (1 boy & 1 girl) per association.

We encourage Federations to nominate female coaches as well.

4th April: arrival day and meeting with coaches.

5th – 9th April: training camp (with tournament)

10th April: departure day.

ITTF HOPES WEEK & CHALLENGE NOMINATIONS (May 2016, Doha, Qatar)

ETTU will select 2 (TWO) girls and 3 (THREE) boys players born 2004 and 2005 from this camp. (Zaharia Elena already nominated)

The whole evaluation procedure will be done by the ETTU coaching team (3 coaches) applying the same criteria from the last year.

FINANCIAL CONDITIONS AND DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES:

Associations should send their entries **NOT later than 14th March 2016** to the Luxembourg Table Tennis Federation (Mr. Massen) - fltt@pt.lu and to Zita Pidl (ETTU, Project Manager) – zpidl.ettu@gmail.com

ETTU will cover subsidy for the accommodation on full board basis for **one girl and one boy / NA's** and the expenses of the camp's organization. However, a fee of **euros 20 per participant per day** shall be charged. Additional players and coaches may be accepted at their own cost of **50 euros per day per person**. This includes accommodation and food (3 meals per day), local transport and free transport to and from Luxembourg airport, train or bus stations.

Free cancellation of participants is possible till: **28th of March 2016**.

For cancellation after 28th of March 2016, CANCELLATION FEE of 120€ will be charged.

VENUE AND ACCOMODATION:

Luxembourg is a founding member of the European Union. Today, it can boast of being one of three European capitals and home to numerous international institutions. The "Schengen" Agreement has been named after the small town "Schengen" in our country, where the agreement was signed in 1985. The country is by tradition a land of meeting and exchange, where more than one third of the local population holds a foreign passport. The population is multilingual and English is widely spoken. Most school-leavers speak fluently French and German. What is more, over a 40% of the population are immigrants, coming mainly from Europe (but not exclusively).

The National Sports Institute of Luxembourg (I.N.S.) is located in Cents-part of Luxembourg City.
