



ACCOMMODATION AND VENUE:

Luxembourg is a founding member of the European Union. Today, it can boast of being one of three European capitals and home to numerous international institutions. The "Schengen" Agreement has been named after the small town "Schengen" in our country, where the agreement was signed in 1985. The country is by tradition a land of meeting and exchange, where more than one third of the local population holds a foreign passport. The population is multilingual and English is widely spoken. Most school-leavers speak fluently French and German. What is more, over a 40% of the population are immigrants, coming mainly from Europe (but not exclusively).



The National Sports Institute of Luxembourg (I.N.S.) is located in Cents-part of Luxembourg City. Under one roof you can find a gymnasium with 20 tables, a Fitness centre, conference rooms, a restaurant, two football fields and a hotel (37 rooms: 20 triple rooms 12 double rooms a 5 single rooms)
