


Dear National Associations Representatives, dear Friends,

The ITTF Education & Training Program is proudly launching the **Rough Diamonds** project, a new initiative for young talented players in the U15 age group that have already showcased their abilities and skills in the international arenas and are aspiring candidates in the route toward excellence.

The project that is the latest addition to the **ITTF Athletes Development Model** as presented below, aims at gathering 10 girls and 10 boys, with their coaches on a joint training camp that will feature high added values in terms of:

- quality coaching intense training process under the watchful eyes of some of the World's best coaches,
- quality training special invitations for up to 8 World best players of the same age group,
- individual approach sparring partners of international level to provide a bigger variety of playing styles, and finally
- **motivational education** a series of educational tools and methods will be introduced to players and coaches following the "learn from the best" principles.



The first ever **Rough Diamonds** selection is based on a comprehensive research about players in the U15 age group, whereby the following criteria and elements were observed:

- participation in ITTF programs, in particular the Hopes,
- **individual development and results** at crucial international events, in particular at World Junior Circuit events,
- **continental representation**, aiming at strengthening performance at the World Cadet Challenge.

4. Training Camp & Educational Sessions

Coaching Team: Head Coaches:

The Head Coaches will be assisted by 2 more coaches from CTTC-E and will work in close cooperation with the Coaches of the participating players.

Tables: 20 tables

Training Partners: 6 training partners

Coach Education: A number of educational sessions will be organized during the Training

Camp, each in the duration of 60-90 minutes. Attendance for the coaches is compulsory.

5. Venue and Hospitality

Venue: National Sports Institute of Luxembourg (I.N.S.)

Sport Hall and Conference Room facilities

The **I.N.S.** is located in Cents-part of Luxembourg City. Under one roof you can find a hall with 20 tables, a fitness center, conference rooms, a restaurant, two football fields and a students' dormitory with 37 rooms.

Hospitality: I.N.S. Students' Dormitory, on full board basis



The participants will be accommodated in triple and double rooms. The selected players will share rooms, while coaches will be accommodated with their fellow coaches.

The facilities feature free Internet (Wi-Fi) access.

All the participants are kindly asked to bring their own towels.

Official Hospitality Package:

The Official Hospitality Package (OHP) for players and coaches includes the following:

- accommodation in I.N.S. Dormitory in double or triple rooms,
- meals on full board basis,
- transfers from/to the Airport and Railway Station on official arrival and departure days.

Participation Support:

The ITTF will cover the following costs:

Rough Diamonds:

- OHP costs for the 20 invited players, with a maximum of 1 girl and 1 boy per National Association;
- OHP costs for 1 coach nominated by the National Association per player.

Special Invitations:

- OHP costs for up to 8 players, with a maximum of 2 girls and 2 boys per National Association;
- OHP for 1 coach per National Association.

Please, note that ITTF will only contribute toward the expenses of the coaches under the following conditions:

- are recognized and nominated by the National Association,
- can provide a national or other coaching certificate, if requested (the ITTF database will be checked automatically),
- they actively work as coaches on a regular basis as National Team coaches or coach the invited player(s) on day to day basis,
- are willing and able to actively assist in coaching all the participating players as required.

Insurance and Indemnity:

All the participants, players and coaches, must have a valid travel insurance covering but not limited to related travel, medical and life insurance; ITTF and the Organizers are not liable for any injury or loss. During the entire duration of the activity players must be supervised by their coaches.

Please, note that according to the ITTF Policy for Underage Players National Associations are responsible for the supervision and wellbeing of their participants, whereby a coach from the National Association must attend with players, ideally a female, when female players are concerned.

Accompanying/ Additional Persons:

Due to the limited number of rooms persons, who are not members of the Official Delegation, cannot stay in the I.N.S. Dormitory.

In case your Delegation includes Accompanying Persons you are welcome to proceed with private arrangements in relation to their staying in Luxembourg.

However, if you need assistance, please do let us know about the intention of entering Accompanying Persons; the Organizers will get back to you informing you about the options and the related rates in due time. Pick-up and drop-off at Luxembourg Airport and Luxembourg Railway Station on official arrival day (5 September) and official departure day (13 September).
